## Tagging The Growth In The Automotive Industry

- In July-2023, MAA revised upwards their forecasted TIV from 650k to 725k units for 2023. For 9M23, Perodua sales rose $18.8 \%$ YoY, while Proton increased $14.1 \%$ YoY and this may benefit BETAMEK as they supply various electronics parts to Perodua.
- MOU between BETAMEK-Shenzhen Zhonghong Technology Co. could provide synergy and produce new products going forward, which is likely to translate to future revenue growth of the group.
- The company showcased growing revenue and earnings its 2QFY24 quarterly report, and its NA per share increased to RM0.32 (from RM0.31) for the quarter.
- The company has been trading at a P/E around $10 x$, which is relatively lower as compared to its counterparts such as EG (P/E: 17.5x) and V.S Industries (P/E: 18.8x).

- Malaysian Automotive Association had in July 2023, revised upwards their forecasted Total Industry Volume for 2023 from 650,000 units to 725,000 units.
- For the nine months of 2023, Perodua has recorded sales for 233,227 units, an increase of $18.78 \%$ YoY as compared to last year of 196,354 units sold. On the other hand, Proton also recorded a noteworthy YoY increase of $14.1 \%$, having sold a total of 116,836 units over the same nine-month period in 2023.
- Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Shenzhen Zhonghong Technology Co. is set to significantly enhance the company's outlook. This strategic move involves the acquisition of new technology, technical know-how and access to new resources and customer base which would improve the Group's future revenue growth.
