Beneficiary of Stronger Upstream O&G Demand

- Petroleum shipping segment is expected to be boosted by increased rates.
- Offshore business to benefit from strong demand for FPSOs.
- LNG segment prospects remain stable from LNG demand in Asia and higher investments in LNG infrastructure.
- Technically, MISC last closed at RM8.01. Monitor for a breakout, targeting RM8.40-8.50, with a LT target at RM8.60. Support is located around RM7.70-7.80, while cut loss is at RM7.65.

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Trading Catalyst

- Petroleum shipping segment is expected to have increased rates on the back of more exports from the Atlantic, higher crude imports in Asia, and potentially stronger tonne-mile demand due to trade route changes amid the tension in the Middle East.
- Offshore business to benefit from strong demand for FPSOs amid the elevated oil prices, which is expected to bolster the upstream O&G sector, hence we should see continued global demand for oil and higher capex spending on O&G infrastructure.
- LNG segment prospects remain stable from LNG demand in Asia and higher investments in LNG infrastructure. Additionally, greater environmental restrictions on vessels as well as the disruptions to the Suez and Panama canals should improve demand for LNG vessels.

Technical Outlook

- Share price has been consolidating around RM7.83 and last closed at RM8.01. As the technical readings are positive, we expect follow-through buying interest to be seen in the near term, targeting RM8.40-8.50, with a LT target at RM8.60. Support is set around RM7.70-7.80, with a cut loss set around RM7.65.

| 1 Day Range Percentile (%) | Calculates the percentile value within the 1-day range |
| 5 Day Range Percentile (%) | Calculates the percentile value within the 5-day range |
| 52 Week Range Percentile (%) | Calculates the percentile value within the 52-week range |
| Volatility 30D | A measure of the risk of price moves for a security calculated from the standard deviation of day-to-day logarithmic historical price changes. The 30-day price volatility equals the annualised standard deviation of the relative price change for the 30 most recent trading days closing price, expressed as a percentage. If EMA9 is greater than EMA20 and EMA20 is greater than EMA60 it will be stated as Uptrend.
