

Selective Plays to Drive Local Market Gains

Market Review

MY: The local bourse traded cautiously ahead of the crucial US August payrolls report, with market breadth negative as 568 losers outpaced 523 gainers. The index was dragged down by PETGAS and SDG. Sector wise, Telecommunications (+1.31%) outperformed, led by MAXIS and TM, while Plantation (-1.64%) lagged the most.

US: Wall Street closed mainly lower Friday after strong labour data fuelled expectations of further Fed rate hikes. Nonfarm payrolls surged by 162K, far above the 50K forecast, lifting bond yields and pressing credit-sensitive sectors. The S&P 500 slipped 0.4% and the Dow dropped 272 points, while the Nasdaq sled 0.3% down.

The Day Ahead

US: Wall Street will be closed for the Labor Day holiday, with normal trading set to resume on Tuesday. Upon reopening, institutional attention is likely to turn towards S&P Dow Jones Indices' quarterly rebalancing. Bloom Energy (BE) is in focus after jumping more than 7% in post-market trading following news of its inclusion in the benchmark S&P 500 alongside Illumina (ILMN) and Everpure (P), replacing Molson Coors Beverage, The Trade Desk and Builders FirstSource. The inclusion further highlights BE's growing exposure to on-site fuel-cell power solutions for AI data centre infrastructure.

MY: Over in Malaysia, the FBM KLCI is expected to remain supported above the 1,700 psychological level, although buying interest may stay selective amid a cautious broader market backdrop. Focus should remain on stock-specific catalysts across infrastructure, renewable energy and industrial growth plays. PEKAT remains a beneficiary of Malaysia's renewable-energy push, with recent strength bringing the stock close to its 52-week high. KEEMING is supported by an indicative order book of approximately RM246m and growing exposure to data centre M&E works. LWSABAH offers a more defensive angle following strong FY2026 earnings, underpinned by resilient East Malaysian beverage demand and expanded production capacity. GAMUDA also remains well supported by its record RM59.6bn order book and expanding data centre exposure, providing strong earnings visibility.

The FBM KLCI maintains a defensive technical outlook as an expanding negative MACD histogram and an RSI nearing 30 signal persistent selling pressure. Resistance sits at 1,723–1,738, while support is established at 1,678–1,693.



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Company Briefs

Zetrix AI Bhd (ZETRIX) has terminated its proposed RM130m share-and-cash deal to acquire a 50% stake in Philippines-based MyEG Ventures Inc announced three days ago. This followed queries from Bursa Malaysia on shareholding, accounting treatment, financial details, and consideration shares. Zetrix cited a review of the commercial rationale, given share price volatility for the consideration shares, as the reason for ending the agreement with Next Lion Ltd. Both parties will be released from their obligations under the agreement, with no break fees or penalties payable by either side. (The Edge)

In a separate announcement, **Zetrix** said it has disposed of its entire 16.9% stake in **HeiTech Padu Bhd** (HTPADU), comprising 27.5m shares, via a direct business transaction dated Sept 2. The sale by unit MyEG Capital Sdn Bhd means Zetrix AI and founder Wong Thean Soon are no longer substantial shareholders. Wong, however, retains a 0.97% direct stake in HeiTech Padu. (The Edge)

BCM Alliance Bhd (BCMALL) has proposed a 10-to-1 share consolidation, reducing issued shares from 2.03bn to about 203.41m, alongside plans to issue up to 30% new shares. This is its second consolidation proposal in eight months, after dropping a similar plan in January. The exercise aims to strengthen its capital structure and may help reduce share price volatility. (The Edge)

Sarawak Consolidated Industries Bhd (SCIB) plans to buy three leasehold land parcels in Kolombong, Kota Kinabalu for RM15.2m cash to expand its presence in Sabah. Its unit, SCIB Ecobuild Sdn Bhd, signed a deal with East Liberty Sdn Bhd for the parcels, which include six shoplots generating RM43,600 monthly rent and two undeveloped plots for future shoplots. SCIB intends to retain the units for a Sabah branch office, with completion targeted by 1Q 2027. (The Edge)

Key Asic Bhd (KEYASIC) has signed a 10-year memorandum of understanding with CT Vision (International) Holdings Ltd to build a large-scale green AI data centre in Malaysia. CT Vision, active in renewable energy and efficiency technologies, will collaborate on integrating green energy with advanced AI computing. The project aims for about 300MW IT load capacity within five years, with a design power usage effectiveness (PUE) of not more than 1.20 and at least 50% energy from green sources, generating recurring income for Key Asic. (The Edge)

HHRG Bhd (HHRG) has appointed tycoon Tan Sri Syed Azman Syed Ibrahim as executive chairman of the biomass firm, effective immediately. Syed Azman, founder of Weststar Aviation, fills a role vacant for over two years. Datuk Ammar Shaikh Mahmood Naim, who chaired HHRG after Datuk H'ng Choon Seng's resignation in June 2024, will continue as executive deputy chairman. (The Edge)

Shin Yang Group Bhd (SYGROUP) will acquire an 8.316-hectare industrial site in Kuching for RM34m via a related-party deal. It entered the deal with Forescom Plywood Sdn Bhd — a unit ultimately held by Shin Yang Holdings Sdn Bhd (SYHSB), which is also the largest shareholder of Shin Yang Group. The property is located within the industrial zone near Kuching Port, and is currently leased from Forescom. (The Edge)

Khee San Bhd (KHEESAN) and subsidiary Khee San Food Industries Sdn Bhd (KFI), along with several current and former directors, are being sued by Tunai Impian Enterprise Sdn Bhd for allegedly failing to honour a consent order tied to an RM18m loan default. Tunai Impian seeks specific performance for KFI to execute the sale and leaseback agreements for the disputed land, or alternatively claims RM65.74m plus 8% annual interest and other relief. (The Edge)



Aumas Resources Bhd (AUMAS) has reported a maiden mineral resource estimate of 110,000 ounces of contained gold for its Andrassy project in Tawau, Sabah. The project, held via wholly owned unit Wullersdorf Resources Sdn Bhd under a prospecting agreement with Aurelius Borneo Mining Sdn Bhd, covers about 18,000 hectares and is valid until July 2027. The estimate, focused on Block 1, includes 45,000 ounces at Bukit Jantung and 64,500 ounces at Bukit Ketupat. (The Edge)

Pulmovant, a subsidiary of **Roivant (ROIV)**, announced that Phase 2 PHocus study results for its inhaled sGC activator, moslicigat, in patients with pulmonary hypertension associated with interstitial lung disease will be presented on Tuesday, September 8, 2026, at the European Respiratory Society International Congress. The presentation will feature findings from the 135-patient trial, building on Phase 1b data where a single dose produced up to a 38% mean peak reduction in pulmonary vascular resistance to address a condition affecting up to 200,000 patients across the U.S. and Europe. Boeing Co. (BA) has been awarded a \$241.3 million sole-source delivery order by the U.S. Navy to repair flight control surfaces for F/A-18 E/F and EA-18G aircraft. The contract, issued under a 2022 basic ordering agreement by the Naval Supply Systems Command Weapon Systems Support, covers nine configurations of flight control surfaces and runs through September 2032. Operations will be split between Jacksonville, Florida (83%), and St. Louis, Missouri (17%), with \$60.3 million in fiscal 2026 working capital funds obligated at award. (Investing.com)
